

## **EPISODE 1: THE CREATION**

**SCRIPTURE REFERENCES:** Genesis 1–3

PRIMARY CHARACTERS: Adam, Eve and the crafty serpent

TIMELINE: Beginning of time. Date unknown.

**LOCATION:** The Garden of Eden – believed to be in the Middle East though unconfirmed.

## CRITICAL FACTS:

- God created the heavens and earth, and all living things that dwell on the earth. God created Adam, the first man, and out of Adam's rib, created Eve, the first woman and the mother of all mankind.
- Adam and Eve disobeyed God by eating of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, resulting in a separation of man from God.
- Adam and Eve, and all mankind following, would not be permitted to eat of the tree of life because of this disobedience.
- God declared that a future offspring of Eve would crush the head of the serpent because of what the serpent had done.
