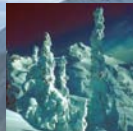

BREAK THOU THE BREAD OF LIFE

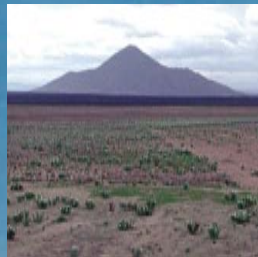
He was known of them in breaking of bread. Luke 24.35
